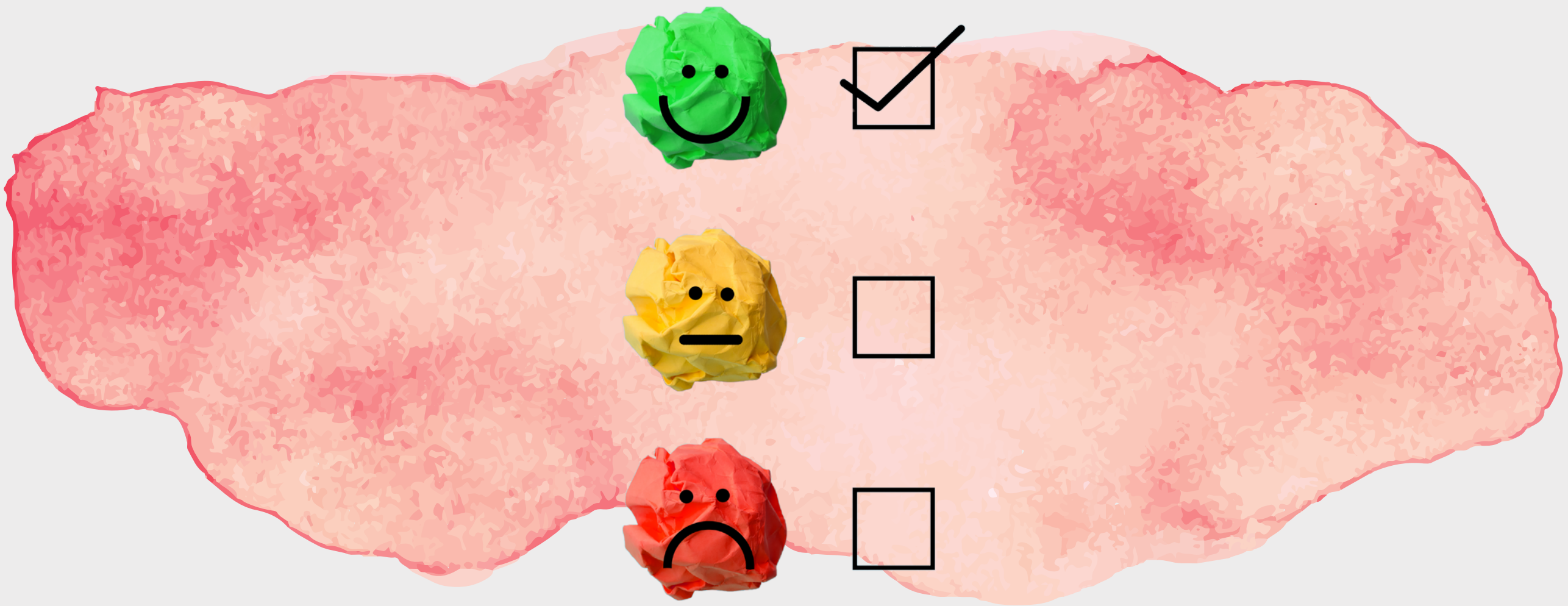
Study VISIT: A farewell surprise!

MEALS

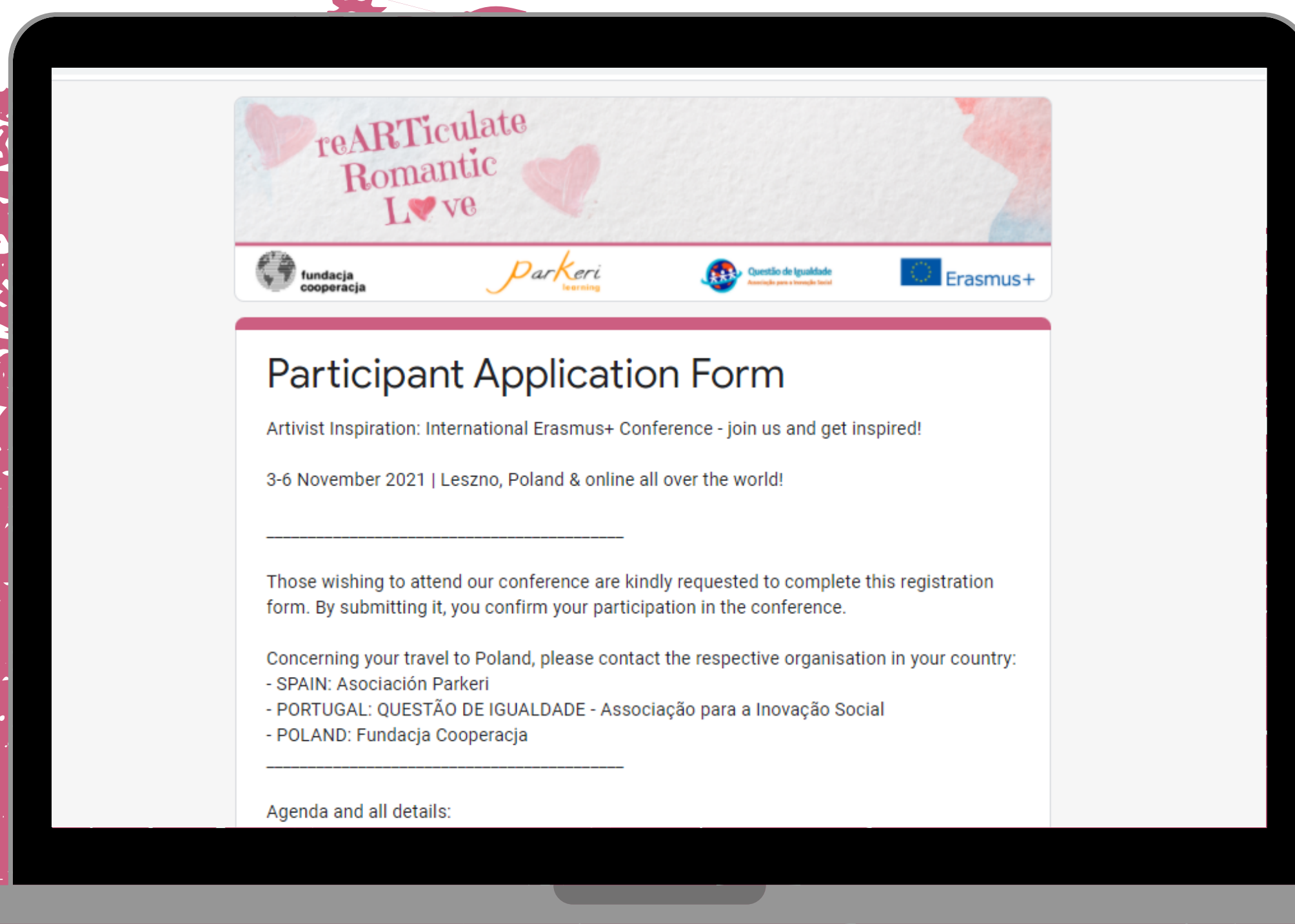
