Short deescription of the organization	Broadening horizons, breaking borders. Behind this motto there is our great faith that through our different activities we will support people's development, as well as we will encourage them to break borders, both internal ones that limit each of us in taking action, and geographical ones, bringing the culture of the countries of the world to our hometown. Foundation Cooperacja is a non-governmental organization operating since November 2019, promoting mobility, multiculturalism, socio-cultural integration, tolerance, inclusion and European values such as equality and unity in diversity. We are young, professionally active people who, out of the need of their heart, decided to take an action in local cultural life and bring some inspiring ideas to people. This is how the Foundation was born in our minds. Why Cooperation? Because we want to cooperate with local entrepreneurs, cultural institutions, as well as other organisations with similar goals at an international level. The foundation's activities are based on our international experience gained through different exchanges and volunteering services. This enabled us to understand the topic of multiculturalism better and opened our minds to diversity. Our foundation's goals are achieved through constant exchange of real life experiences, knowledge and best practices. In order to do so, we are		

developing and organizing different workshops, seminars, conferences, meetings and cultural events both at local and international level. All our activities are based on non-formal education methods and mobility opportunities including different target groups.

Our foundation consists of people experienced in developing and implementing local and international projects. We would like to share our experience and knowledge with international partners in order to exchange good practices and solutions. We intend to learn more, improve and establish good network connections at international level, as well as keep developing with the local society and help them to improve.

What we do:

- we support refugees, migrants and migrant women in the integration process by providing free Polish language lessons, consulting provided as part of the mobile infopoint for foreigners, organizing cultural and animation activities and intercultural workshops;
- we increase access to culture (including the so-called high culture) and expand the cultural offer in the region by organizing workshops and study visits - reaching places where access to culture is limited;
- we promote and protect tangible and intangible cultural heritage by cultivating local traditions, legends and stories and their preservation, and do renovation of a historical well in a village in Lower Silesia as well as cleaning the surrounding area to create a place for integration;
- we stimulate social and civic activity and promote democracy by animating and supporting various environments, of all ages;
- we promote well-being, physical activity and contact with nature by organizing outdoor initiatives, bushcrafting and wellbeing training;
- we conduct educational activities using the methods of informal education, mainly thanks to the creation of international cooperation networks for important social problems;
- we join and initiate various activities, projects and anti-discrimination and equality campaigns through campaigns to promote social diversity.

We are a young organisation but our team is experienced in developing many local and international projects. Our latest activity was concentrated on our local society, especially people in danger of social exclusion, as well as NEET youth. Our aim was to introduce the culture to them and bring it closer, out of museums and other formal institutions. All those activities were taken in order to promote inclusion using different, creative methods. Our team is extremely motivated to work and wills to involve people in getting as much as possible from international cooperation and from it have a real impact at local level. Our experience gives us some background of the reality faced nowadays in the community, but more than that we believe this cooperation can give us more ideas and strategies to face the problems from different and creative approaches.

What are the activities and experience of the organisation in the areas relevant for this application?

In the local community in Leszno, as well as in different places in Europe, there is the need to constant adapt to the labour reality, being constant updated and developing. This is a crucial point our foundation works with. We are very focused on developing creativity and creative ways of doing the old things (keeping the traditions and the background which is important) better. By that we mean, investing in personal development of people as well as in the society itself, by developing it through different ideas and methods. Foundation Cooperacja's team consists mostly of young, educated and creative specialists in international relations, involved and motivated to promote active participation and constant personal development. The foundation has an experienced team in mobility projects such as youth exchanges, EVS, seminars and training courses (in topics such as creativity, healthy lifestyle, leadership, cultural exchange, environment and civil protection, social communication, human rights, etc).

Our Foundation is composed of two permanent members, with different background experiences.

The President is a very experienced person in the field of non-formal education, working for many years as a local animator and project developer. Our vice-president professionally works in public administration, but also has a big knowledge about non-governmental environments. Both of them speak English fluently and have well developed management skills. All our members and people involved in the foundation have extensive professional experience in international environment, conflict resolution and monitoring projects.
